WHEREAS, Mr. Butler played a vital role in the creation of the Balcones Canyonlands Preserve, which has set a standard for habitat conservation and is one of the largest urban preserves in the country; he also helped formulate the Barton Springs-Edwards Aquifer groundwater conservation district, the tangible markers of which are the signs throughout Austin that delineate the limits of the Edwards Aquifer Recharge Zone; and

WHEREAS, A man of courage, strength, and compassion, he gave unselfishly to others, and his down-to-earth demeanor, his passion for the profession of teaching, and his enthusiasm for living each day to the fullest will not be forgotten by those who knew him; and
