IN RE: HB34 by Branch (relating to including in the public high school curriculum instruction in methods of paying for postsecondary education and training.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would require revision of the economics Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills to include methods of paying for postsecondary education and training. Costs at the Texas Education Agency to implement the provisions of the bill are not expected to be significant.
