**IN RE: HB34** by Branch (Relating to including in the public high school curriculum instruction in methods of paying for postsecondary education and training.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would require revision to the economics Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS). The agency estimates there would be a small cost associated with implementing the provisions of the bill, but that cost is not anticipated to be significant.
