IN RE: HB63 by Martinez, "Mando" (Relating to the authority of certain school districts to lay in county rights-of-way fiber optic cable or other means of transmitting information.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Education Code to authorize and provide procedures for school districts within 60 miles of the Texas-Mexico border to place fiber optic cable or another means of transmitting information in a county right-of-way.
