**IN RE: HB122** by Veasey (relating to proof that is acceptable for identifying individuals acknowledging written instruments.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

The bill would amend the Civil Practice and Remedies Code requiring an officer to accept a current passport issued by a foreign government as satisfactory evidence of the identity of a person.
