IN RE: HB129 by Alvarado (Relating to prohibiting the manufacture and sale of certain children's products containing bisphenol-A or certain other substances.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would prohibit the manufacturing or sale of child products with bisphenol-A or other "known to be human carcinogen" chemicals. This analysis assumes there would be no significant fiscal impact to the Department of State Health Services. The bill would take effect September 1, 2011.
