**IN RE: HB143** by Laubenberg (Relating to the issuance of specialty license plates to certain family members of a person who dies while serving in the United States armed forces.), **As Engrossed**

<p><b>No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.</b></p>

The bill would amend Section 504.408 of the Transportation Code to allow issuance of Gold Star Father specialty license plates to the father of a person who dies while serving in the United States Armed Forces.

Under the current provisions of Section 504.408, Transportation Code, the fee for issuance of the plate would be \$10. Based on the information and analysis provided by DMV, it is assumed implementation of the bill would not result in a significant impact to the State and any additional costs or duties could be absorbed within the agency's existing resources.

**Local Government Impact**

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
