**IN RE: HB168** by Raymond (Relating to the requirements of a bail bond.), **As Introduced**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Code of Criminal Procedure to require that a bail bond state an expiration date of not later than the third anniversary of the date the principal signed the bond. There is currently no expiration date on a bond.
