IN RE: HB564 by Craddick (Relating to maintenance of portable fire extinguishers in governmentowned vehicles in certain local governmental jurisdictions.), Committee Report 1st House, Substituted

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Local Government Code to require a local government that adopts an ordinance or order to install portable fire extinguishers in government-owned vehicles to annually inspect the fire extinguishers.

Local Government Impact

It is assumed that a local government would only adopt an ordinance or rule if sufficient funds were available for the installation and annual inspections; therefore, no significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
