IN RE: HB812 by King, Phil (Relating to the definition of peace officer for purposes of intercepting or collecting information in relation to certain communications in an investigation of criminal conduct.), **As Engrossed**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Code of Criminal Procedure to include a fire marshal or related officer, inspector or investigator commissioned by a county under Subchapter B, Chapter 352 in the definition of an authorized peace officer.
