IN RE: HB988 by Kolkhorst (Relating to compensatory time accrued by a correctional officer employed by the Texas Department of Criminal Justice.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would extend the period of time a Department of Criminal Justice correctional officer has to use compensatory time from 12 to 24 months. The Texas Department of Criminal Justice anticipates no significant fiscal impact from this bill.
