**IN RE: HB1103** by Lucio III (Relating to conditions of community supervision for persons convicted of certain criminal offenses involving animal cruelty.), **Conference Committee Report**

The bill would amend the Code of Criminal Procedure to authorized a judge that grants community supervision to a person convicted of an offense involving animal cruelty to require the person to attend a responsible pet owner course according to guidelines in the bill. The bill would take effect September 1, 2011.
