**IN RE: HB1136** by Aycock (relating to requiring an election authority to provide notice to certain county chairs regarding certain election activities.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Election Code to require an election authority to provide written notice by mail, electronic mail, or another form of written communication of a meeting called by an election authority regarding an upcoming election to the county chair of each political party that made nominations by primary election. The bill would exclude a city secretary from the definition of an election authority.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
