IN RE: HB1136 by Aycock (Relating to requiring an election authority to provide notice to certain county chairs regarding certain election activities.), Committee Report 2nd House, Substituted

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Election Code to require an election officer to hold a meeting with the county chair of each political party to discuss certain election information and to provide written notice by mail, electronic mail, or another form of written communication of a meeting called by an election officer regarding an upcoming election to the county chair of each political party that made nominations by primary election.

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
