IN RE: HB1241 by Zedler (Relating to surety bond requirements for reserve deputy constables.), As Introduced

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Local Government Code to authorize a constable to execute a blanket surety bond to cover more than one reserve deputy constable. The bill also would authorize a county to selfinsure against losses instead of a reserve deputy constable executing an individual or blanket surety bond.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
