IN RE: HB1283 by Craddick (relating to consideration of a bidder 's principal place of business in awarding certain municipal contracts.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Local Government Code to increase the amount of an expenditure for a nonconstruction related service from \$100,000 to \$500,000 for which a municipality may consider entering into certain contracts. Construction services would maintain the original limit of \$100,000.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
