IN RE: HB1379 by Anchia (Relating to the purchasing of a firearm from the county by an honorably retired law enforcement officer.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Local Government Code to authorize a county to sell a firearm to an honorably retired commissioned peace officer. The county would be required to establish the amount, which may not exceed fair market value.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
