Introduced

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill relates to limitations on the number of courses students may drop under certain circumstances at certain public institutions of higher education. The bill clarifies existing language by specifically naming "general academic teaching institution" and "medical and dental unit", instead of "institution of higher education". Provisions of the bill would be implemented within existing resources.
