**IN RE: HB1660** by Davis, Yvonne (Relating to the provision of video programming service to consumers.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Business and Commerce Code and prohibits a video programming service provider from offering a consumer a contract for video programming service that contains a cancellation fee or a time during the contract period when cancellation is not available. It is anticipated that any additional costs associated with implementation of the legislation could be absorbed within existing resources.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
