IN RE: HB1706 by Gutierrez (Relating to the punishment for the offense of criminal mischief.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend Section 28.03(b) of the Penal Code to change the amount of pecuniary loss on Class B and Class C misdemeanors from less than \$50 to less than \$100.
