**IN RE: HB1814** by Lucio III (Relating to the provision of water and certain equipment by water supply or sewer service corporations for use in fire suppression and the liability of those corporations.), **Committee Report 2nd House, Substituted** 

## No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Water Code to authorize a corporation to enter into a contract with a governmental entity to provide a water supply to a governmental entity or a volunteer fire department for use in fire suppression. A corporation that provides a water supply or fire hydrant equipment would be liable for damages only to the extent that a governmental entity would be liable.

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
