IN RE: HB1825 by Price (Relating to permit application and amendment hearings conducted by groundwater conservation districts and the State Office of Administrative Hearings.),
Committee Report 1st House, Substituted

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Water Code relating to permit application and amendment hearings conducted by groundwater conservation districts and the State office of Administrative Hearings.

Based on the analysis of the State Office of Administrative Hearings and the Water Development Board, it is assumed that the duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be accomplished by utilizing existing resources.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
