**IN RE: HB1834** by Shelton (Relating to elimination of certain requirements for increasing community awareness of prekindergarten programs offered by or in partnership with school districts.), **As Introduced**

The bill would repeal statutory requirements related to promoting awareness of prekindergarten programs. Fiscal impact to the operations of the Texas Education Agency is not expected to be significant.

**Local Government Impact**

The bill would repeal certain reporting requirements for school districts related to promoting awareness of prekindergarten programs and related annual reporting requirements, which could result in some local administrative savings.
