**IN RE: HB1839** by Phillips (relating to excluding a provider of recreational classes that do not lead to an educational credential from regulation as a career school or college.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

The bill would exempt career schools or colleges from the requirements in Education Code Ch. 132 (A) if the program provides certain recreational or avocational instruction or teacher instruction.
