IN RE: HB2047 by Lewis (relating to service of process at the registered office of certain registered agents.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would require a registered agent that is an organization to have an employee available at the registered office during normal business hours to receive service of process, notice, or demand.
