IN RE: HB2518 by Kolkhorst (Relating to the transfer of certain state property from the Texas Board of Criminal Justice to the board of regents of The Texas A&M University System for the use and benefit of the Texas Forest Service.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would direct the Texas Board of Criminal Justice to transfer to the board of regents of the Texas A&M University System certain real property. The bill would also require the board of regents of the Texas A&M University System to use the property for the benefit of the Texas Forest Service.
