**IN RE: HB2651** by Allen (Relating to the eligibility of visitors to use certain public transportation services for people with disabilities.), **As Introduced** 

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Transportation Code to define "provider" as a public transportation provider that provides public transportation for people with disabilities, and "services" as public transportation services provided by a public transportation provider designed for people with disabilities. A provider would be required to determine if a person who seeks to use a provider's services while visiting the provider's service area is eligible within 48 hours after an individual provides the appropriate notice and required documentation.

## **Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
