IN RE: HB2904 by Zerwas (Relating to the administration of a centralized Texas organ donation registry.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill makes several revisions to the administration of the Texas organ donor registry.

It is assumed any costs associated with implementation of the provisions in the bill, including the development of a competitive Request for Proposal to contract with a non-profit organization to establish and maintain the Donate Life-Texas Registry, can be absorbed within existing agency resources.

Local Government Impact

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
