IN RE: HB3245 by Elkins (Relating to a photograph on a personal identification certificate, driver's license, or commercial driver's license.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Transportation Code to permit the Department of Public Safety (DPS) to include a grayscale or color photograph personal identification certificate, or a grayscale photograph on a driver's license or commercial driver's license. The bill would take effect September 1, 2011. This analysis assumes DPS could implement the provisions of the bill within existing appropriations.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
