**IN RE: HB3285** by Guillen (Relating to considering the assessment instrument results of certain students in evaluating school district and campus performance.), **As Introduced** 

### No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would prohibit the consideration of student performance on a state assessment in evaluating school districts and campus performance in the state accountability system for three years for students identified as having limited English proficiency.

### **Local Government Impact**

School districts would not have the assessment results of students with limited English proficiency included in their accountability ratings for campuses and districts for a period of three years. The bill does not state when that three year window begins.
