**IN RE: HB3344** by Isaac (Relating to competitive bid requirements for public utility agencies that award construction contracts.), **As Introduced** 

#### No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Local Government Code to increase the amount that a public utility agency is authorized to award a construction contract to on the basis of competitive bids to more than \$50,000. Under current statute, the amount is more than \$20,000. The provision would exclude a contract necessary from unforeseen damage to property or public equipment.

#### **Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
