IN RE: HB3369 by King, Susan (Relating to the registration of certain physical therapy facilities by the Texas Board of Physical Therapy Examiners.), **As Engrossed**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Occupations Code relating to the registration of certain physical therapy facilities.

Based on information provided by the Executive Council of Physical Therapy and Occupational Therapy Examiners, it is assumed that duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be accomplished by utilizing existing resources.
