**IN RE: HB3372** by King, Tracy O. (Relating to standards for a structure that is connected to a public water supply system and has a rainwater harvesting system.), **As Engrossed**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would require the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) to adopt rules to remove current language that limits the use of rainwater to non-potable uses if the structure is connected to a public water system. The bill would allow for the connection to a public water system if the rainwater system has appropriate cross-connection safeguards. The bill's passage is not expected to result in a significant fiscal impact to the TCEQ.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
