**IN RE: SB482** by Harris (Relating to authorization agreements between parents and nonparent relatives of a child.), **As Engrossed**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Family Code relating to the requirements of an authorization agreement for a nonparent relative of a child. The bill modifies some of the requirements surrounding authorization agreements for a nonparent relative of a child. These agreements are made outside of court supervision and would have no impact on court operations.

The bill would take effect September 1, 2011.

**Local Government Impact**
