**IN RE: SB709** by Van de Putte (Relating to the use of certain professional titles by licensed specialists in school psychology.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Occupations Code relating to the use of certain professional titles by licensed specialists in school psychology.

Based on information provided by the Board of Examiners of Psychologists, it is assumed that duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be accomplished by utilizing existing resources.
