IN RE: SB873 by Duncan (Relating to rate and damage schedules governing certain easements or other interests in land of The University of Texas System.), **As Engrossed**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

Under provisions of the bill, the Board of Regents of the University of Texas System would establish procedures by which a person seeking an easement or other interest under Section 66.46 of the Education Code may seek relief from a rate or damage schedule that the person believes does not represent the fair market value of the interest being sought.
