IN RE: SB910 by Lucio (Relating to certain state attorneys called into active duty military service.),
As Engrossed

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Government Code to define an “active duty state attorney” and would require a court to excuse such attorney from a court appearance or attendance provided the attorney has delegated the responsibilities and notified the presiding judge.
