**IN RE: SB910** by Lucio (Relating to certain state attorneys called into active duty military service.),  
**As Introduced**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Government Code to define an “active duty state attorney” and would require a court to excuse such attorney from a court appearance or attendance provided the attorney has delegated the responsibilities and notified the presiding judge.
