**IN RE: SB966** by Uresti (Relating to high school diplomas for certain military veterans.), **As Introduced**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would extend the authority to school districts to issue high school diplomas to military veterans of the United States armed forces who did not graduate high school and who meet certain criteria to include those who have served in the conflicts in Afghanistan and Iraq since 1989.

**Local Government Impact**

School districts' authority to issue high school diplomas to military veterans of the United States armed forces who did not graduate high school and who meet certain criteria would be extended to include those who have served in the conflicts in Afghanistan and Iraq since 1989.
