**IN RE: SB995** by Fraser (Relating to the sale of souvenir bottles of distilled spirits by the holder of a distiller's and rectifier's permit.), **As Engrossed**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Alcoholic Beverage Code to allow the holders of distiller and rectifier's permits to sell souvenir bottles of distilled spirits. The Texas Alcoholic and Beverage Commission indicates that no fiscal implication is anticipated.
