IN RE: SB1036 by Williams (Relating to notice required in connection with possessory liens on motor vehicles.), Committee Report 1st House, Substituted

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Property Code to require the holder of a garageman's lien under Section 70.003(c), including a vehicle storage facility licensed under Chapter 2303, Occupations Code, to file a copy of the lien notice in a county tax assessor-collector's office and remit a \$25 administrative fee to the county tax assessor-collector in the county in which the garage or licensed vehicle storage facility is located.
