**IN RE: SB1036** by Williams (Relating to notice required in connection with possessory liens on motor vehicles.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Property Code to require the holder of a garageman's lien under Section 70.003(c), including a vehicle storage facility licensed under Chapter 2303, Occupations Code, to file a copy of the lien notice in a county tax assessor-collector's office and remit a \$25 administrative fee to the county tax assessor-collector in the county in which the garage or licensed vehicle storage facility is located.

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
