IN RE: SB1292 by Hegar (Relating to the issuance of a driver's license to a peace officer that includes an alternative to the officer's residence address.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Transportation Code to permit the Department of Public Safety to issue a driver's license to a peace officer that contains an alternative address than the actual address of the peace officer. The bill includes provisions regarding the procedures required of issuing a driver's license with an alternative address to a peace officer. The bill would take effect September 1, 2011. No significant fiscal impact to the state is anticipated.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
