IN RE: SB1330 by Watson (Relating to the driver safety courses for individuals younger than 25 receiving deferred disposition for certain traffic offenses.), Committee Report 1st House, Substituted

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would require the commissioner of education to adopt rules establishing minimum standards for curriculum and educational materials to be used in a driving safety course designed for drivers younger than 25 years of age. The Texas Education Agency estimates no significant fiscal implications associated with the required rules adoption.
