**IN RE: SB1532** by Hinojosa (Relating to a photograph on a personal identification certificate, driver's license, or commercial driver's license.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Transportation Code to permit the Department of Public Safety (DPS) to include a grayscale or color photograph personal identification certificate, or a grayscale photograph on a driver's license or commercial driver's license. The bill would take effect September 1, 2011. This analysis assumes DPS could implement the provisions of the bill within existing appropriations.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
