**IN RE: SB1562** by Williams (Relating to the designation of a segment of Texas State Highway 75 as the 75th Ranger Regiment Highway.), **As Introduced** 

### No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would require the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) to design, construct, and erect highway markers designating a segment of State Highway 75 as the 75th Ranger Regiment Highway, subject to Section 225.021 (c), Transportation Code.

Section 225.021 (c) of the Transportation Code, specifies that TxDOT is not required to design, construct, or erect the marker unless a grant or donation of funds is made to the department to cover the cost. Based on the analysis provided by TxDOT, it is assumed any duties associated with the implementation of the provisions of the bill could be absorbed within the agency's existing resources.

### **Local Government Impact**

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
