The chair called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m. There being a quorum present, the following business was transacted:

Senator Birdwell moved that the minutes of the March 2, 2011, hearing be approved. The motion was adopted by unanimous consent.

The chair laid out SB 633 and recognized Senator Watson, to explain the bill by Senator Hinojosa. SB 633 was left pending.

At 8:03 a.m. Senator Birdwell assumed the chair.

The Chair laid out SB 28 and recognized the author, Senator Zaffirini, to explain the bill. SB 28 was left pending.

The Chair laid out SB 282 and recognized the author, Senator Zaffirini, to explain the bill. Senator Zaffirini sent up the committee substitute for SB 282 and moved its adoption.
