SB 316 Relating to criminal asset forfeiture, the disposition of proceeds and property from criminal asset forfeiture, and accountability for that disposition; providing civil penalties. SB 407 Watson | et al. Relating to the creation of the offense of electronic transmission of certain visual material depicting a minor and to certain educational programs concerning the prevention and awareness of that offense. Whitmire SB 623 Relating to the disgualification of a district or county attorney who is the subject of a criminal investigation. SB 887 Carona | et al. Relating to the penalty for theft of an automated teller machine or the contents or components of an automated teller machine. SB 1680 Ellis Relating to certain evidence in a prosecution of fraud or theft involving Medicaid or Medicare benefits and to certain criminal procedures involving offenses in general.
