14 subsection, a declaration of write-in candidacy for the office

15 sought by the deceased or ineligible candidate may be filed not

16 later than 6 [5] p.m. of the eighth [59th] day after the date of the

17 regular filing deadline for the general primary election [before

18 election day].

19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
