A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the composition of districts for the election of
- 3 members of the Texas House of Representatives.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The redistricting plan identified as PLANH312 on
- 6 the redistricting computer system operated by the Texas Legislative
- 7 Council is adopted as the permanent plan for districts used to elect
- 8 members of the Texas House of Representatives.
- 9 SECTION 2. (a) This Act supersedes all previous enactments
- 10 or orders adopting districts for the Texas House of
- 11 Representatives. All previous acts of the legislature adopting
- 12 districts for the Texas House of Representatives are repealed.
- 13 (b) Chapter 1271 (H.B. 150), Acts of the 82nd Legislature,
- 14 Regular Session, 2011 (Article 195a-12, Vernon's Texas Civil
- 15 Statutes), is repealed.
- 16 SECTION 3. The districts included in the redistricting plan
- 17 adopted under Section 1 of this Act apply to the election of the
- 18 members of the Texas House of Representatives beginning with the
- 19 primary and general elections in 2014 for members of the 84th
- 20 Legislature. This Act does not affect the membership or districts
- 21 of the House of Representatives of the 83rd Texas Legislature.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 3 legislative session.
